Earning PRIDE Points

Students are capable of earning PRIDE Points, or tickets, for demonstrating the characteristics listed below. The more tickets students are able to earn, the more they have demonstrated these traits.

A Hernwood PRIDE stamp will indicate that your student displayed appropriate PRIDE behaviors for the day. Comments will also be written to encourage communication between the parents/guardians and teachers to better assist the students in learning. Comments may be left to explain positive choices that students have made, reasons why they earned a PRIDE point for the day, or to explain a difficulty that may have occurred during the day. Please understand that comments may not be left daily. We will keep you up to date on your student's progress while at Hernwood.

Effective Procedures for Dealing with Problem Behaviors

All teachers will be following a positive behavior program using the progressive discipline consequences listed below when problem behaviors occur. Category I, II and III behavior offenses, as specified in the Student Behavior Handbook, will result in an automatic office referral.

- 1st Offense: Verbal Warning
- 2nd Offense: Time Out in the Classroom
- 3rd Offense: Buddy Room with a PAWS and THINK Form
 - o Signed and Returned by Parent
- 4th Offense: Limited Choice Recess or Parent Phone Call
- 5th Offense: Behavior Intervention Teacher Referral
 - o Parent Phone Call, Behavior Referral Signed and Returned by Parent
- 6th Offense: Office Referral
 - o Parent Phone Call, Individualized Student Consequence
